Birth to 1 month

Has the five basic senses

Feeds 5 to 8 times per day

Sleeps for about 20 hours each day

Can see colours and will start making cries, coos, and grunts

Will start smiling and staring at faces.

May be soothed by rocking

1 to 3 months

4 to 6 months

Will start to recognize people and will enjoy being cuddled by them

Starts babbling and being able to roll over

Begins sitting without support and crawling.

Mummy becomes the most important person in baby's world

Enjoys peek-a-boo

7 to 9 months



10 to 12 months

Able to stand, play pat-a-cake, and wave hello or bye-bye

Responds to own name

Baby's first words!

Can walk and climb up stairs

Starting to draw

Understands a few words

Feeds self

1 to 1.5 years

1.5 to 2 years

Vocabulary of more than 200 words

Has temper tantrums and tests parents' authority

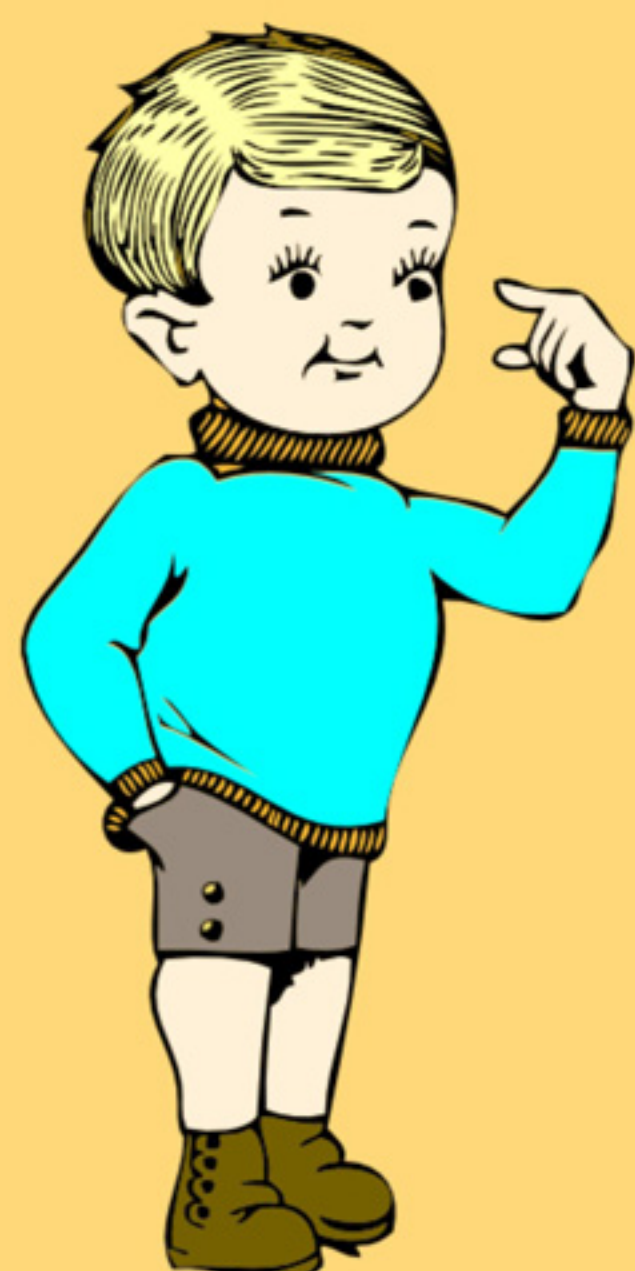
Capable of bowel and bladder control
