

10 Games to Play in the Snow

When winter starts, the fun begins! Check out these games to play in the snow with your child!

For the Birds



String Cranberries, popcorn, and cereal onto fishing line for a garland to attract and nourish your feathered friends!

Cold Molds



Borrow some pans from the kitchen and use them to build snowy fairy castles or cakes for a cold weather "feast".

Sugar Daddy



Give your snowman a candy-coated makeover with licorice, lollipops, and gummies.

Ice and Easy



Freeze coloured water into ice cubes, then hide them around the yard for a wintertime scavenger hunt!



Practice Your Pitch

Paint a bull's eye target on a piece of cardboard, giving each coloured ring a point value. Attach it to a tree, and keep score as the kids try to hit the target with snowballs.



Take turns following each others' leads as you move like different animals. Waddle like a penguin and stomp like a bear!

Make a golf course by packing down a section of snow every few feet. Bury tin cans halfway into the snow to create holes, and mark them with mini flag sticks.

Pass out chocolate cookies, then blindfold each child and let them try to get the mouth, eyes, and buttons in place.

Tic-Tac-Snow

Two players go for the championship in this classic game. Draw out your board in the snow and use criss-crossed sticks and pine cones as game pieces.
